Main educational program of higher education in 31.05.01 «General Medicine»

Qualification - specialist, General practitioner

Standard term of study - 6 years

The basic professional educational program (BPEP) of a specialist, implemented by the Federal State Autonomous Educational Institution of Higher Education "Far Eastern Federal University" in the specialty 31.05.01 General Medicine is a system of documents developed and approved by a higher educational institution, taking into account the requirements of the labor market on the basis of the Federal State Educational standard of higher education (FGOS VO 3++) General Medicine, approved by order of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation dated August 12, 2020 No. 988.

The orientation of the BPOP is focused on: the formation of a specialist who carries out medical practice in the field of medical practice.

Goals and objectives of the main professional educational program

The purpose of the OBEP HE is to develop students' personal qualities, the formation of general cultural, general professional and professional competencies in accordance with the federal state educational standard of higher education in the direction of training 31.05.01 "General Medicine" (specialist level), which determine the graduate's ability to active social and professional activities or continuing education.

Types of professional activities for which graduates who have mastered the specialist's program are preparing:

- medical;
- organizational and managerial;
- research.

A graduate who has mastered the specialty program is ready to solve the

following professional tasks in accordance with the type (types) of professional activity to which the specialty program is (are) oriented to:

medical activity:

Providing medical care to the patient in urgent or emergency forms.

Examination of the patient in order to establish a diagnosis.

Prescribing treatment and monitoring its effectiveness and safety.

Implementation and control of the effectiveness of the patient's medical rehabilitation, including the implementation of individual programs for the rehabilitation or habilitation of the disabled, assessment of the patient's ability to work.

Carrying out and monitoring the effectiveness of measures to prevent and promote a healthy lifestyle and sanitary and hygienic education of the population.

organizational and managerial activities:

Maintaining medical records and organizing the activities of the nursing staff at the disposal.

research activities:

analysis of scientific literature and official statistical reviews, participation in statistical analysis and public presentation of the results;

participation in solving individual research and scientific-applied tasks in the field of health care for diagnosis, treatment, medical rehabilitation and prevention.

When developing and implementing a specialist's program, the FEFU School of Medicine focuses on a specific type (types) of professional activity for which (which) a specialist is preparing, based on the needs of the labor market, research and material and technical resources of the organization.

The labor intensity of the BPEP in the direction of training

31.05.01 General medicine

Labor intensity of the BPOP HE 31.05.01 General medicine is 360 credits. The term of study according to the Federal State Educational Standard 3 ++ in the direction of training in the specialty 31.05.01 General Medicine is 6 years. Education under the specialist's program at the FEFU School of Medicine is carried out on a

full-time basis. When implementing the specialist's program at the FEFU School of Medicine, e-learning and distance learning technologies are used. Implementation of the specialist's program using exclusively e-learning, distance learning technologies in accordance with the Federal State Educational Standard of Higher Education 31.05.01 General medicine is not allowed. BPOP HE in the specialty 31.05.01 General medicine is carried out on the English language.

Specific features of the BPOP HE 31.05.01 General Medicine

Applicants with a secondary general education are accepted to study at the Basic Professional Educational Program (BPEP) in the specialty 31.05.01 General Medicine in accordance with the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation of October 14, 2015 No. 1147 "On approval of the procedure for admission to study in educational programs higher education - bachelor's programs, specialist's programs, master's programs" (with amendments and additions).

The relevance of the main professional educational program is due to the state strategy for the prevention of public health in the Russian Federation, the implementation of state programs and innovative projects in the healthcare system, the development of medical science and consists in the preparation of highly qualified professionals who are competitive, in demand in the labor market, able to adapt to rapidly changing socio-economic conditions the lives of the next generation of professionals.

A graduate in the specialty 31.05.01 General Medicine receives a diploma of higher education, and after passing primary accreditation, he has the right to carry out independent medical and preventive activities in the position of a local general practitioner in accordance with the Professional Standard. The training of a doctor allows him to continue his education in residency, postgraduate studies under the programs for training highly qualified personnel. After graduating from residency, having received a specialty, a doctor can work both in outpatient and inpatient healthcare units, regardless of the form of ownership according to the specialty received. After graduating from graduate school, a doctor can defend a dissertation

for the degree of candidate of medical sciences and continue working in practical healthcare, in educational medical institutions, and research medical institutions.

In the learning process, the School of Medicine implements academic subjects and practices that ensure the formation of all the necessary universal, general professional and professional competencies, including: medical foreign language, medical statistics, medical informatics, general and medical chemistry, biochemistry, human anatomy, human physiology, human histology, pathological anatomy, pathological physiology, public health, healthcare organization, health economics, hygiene, propaedeutics of internal diseases, therapy (faculty, hospital, polyclinic), topographic anatomy and operative surgery, surgery (general, faculty, hospital), obstetrics and gynecology, traumatology and orthopedics, infectious diseases, microbiology, virology, human immunology, educational and production practices.

FEFU implements an organizational model of inclusive education - ensuring equal access to education for all students, taking into account various special educational needs and individual abilities of students.

FEFU forms its educational system in accordance with its specifics, traditions, strategic priorities for the development of the Far East and the mission of the university in the Asia-Pacific region, the global educational space, represents the value-normative, methodological, methodological and technological foundations for organizing educational activities at the present stage of development university.
